IFB 25578 – Responses to Questions from Prospective Bidders

1. Could you please provide a former quarterly report so we may ascertain the level of effort?

2. Is calibration equipment (i.e. DeltaCal and BIOS DryCal or equivalents) owned by RIAC and available for use?
Selected vendor shall provide necessary calibration equipment and associated expendables to be included in your cost.
3. Will this be invoiced as a lump sum or time and materials project?
This is a lump sum annual fee with monthly invoice. RIAC will request scope and fee for any work outside the scope of the contract which will be executed through a Task Order.
4. What are the anticipated dates for award and project transition?
November 1, 2014 is anticipated contract award. Transition would need to be coordinated through RIAC with existing vendor.
5. Is a maintenance schedule available for review?
No. The selected vendor will be required to develop and provide a QAPP which should include a maintenance schedule in accordance with manufacturer specifications and good practices.
