Q: Are all students allowed to bring vehicles on campus? If not, which student class is not allowed?

A: RIC - All students are allowed to bring vehicles on campus.

URI - All students are allowed to bring vehicles on campus.

Q: Do you have data that shows what % of students per class have a vehicle on campus?

A: RIC – 6,302 Undergraduate and 1,066 Graduate students are commuters.

URI – Approximately 30% of resident students have vehicles, which is about 1,900 out of 6,400. Additionally, there are over 7,000 commuters.

Q: What % of your student population is undergraduate? Graduate? International students?

A: RIC – 87% Undergraduate, 13% graduate, and 2% International.

URI - 82% Undergraduate, 14% graduate, and 4% International.

Q: The bid mentioned faculty rentals, what percentage of the vehicle usage is currently utilized by faculty?

A: RIC & URI - Not Available, but estimated faculty and staff usage is less than 1%.

Q: Could you please describe the type of marketing support you have provided based upon prior experience?

A: RIC & URI – The current vendor does all the marketing. The College and the University provides space for vendor marketing material and the University features car-sharing information on the sustainability website.

Q: Do you have a preference in terms of vehicle you would like to have on campus? Number, type, ?

A: RIC – At this time RIC has no preference. – RIC currently has 2 vehicles on campus.

URI – Yes, Hybrid vehicles are preferred.
