



Rhode Island Housing Announces Housing Preservation and Production Program Funding

Application Deadline: 5 p.m. Wednesday, September 30, 2015

Rhode Island Housing announces the opening of a competitive funding round for Housing Preservation and Production Program (“HPPP”) funding. Approximately \$3 million in funding is available to preserve existing affordable housing. Rhode Island Housing anticipates funding of up to 300 affordable apartments.

Applicants should review the HPPP guidelines which set forth the Threshold Criteria and Priorities which will be used to evaluate applications.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- There is only one acceptable application form. It is posted on the Rhode Island Housing website on our [RFP page](#), and at the State’s [Division of Purchases page](#).
- Incomplete applications and those omitting requested documentation will not be evaluated.
- Applicants must submit three hard copies.
- Applicants may submit proposals for more than one project.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION:

All applications are due by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 30, 2015. Three hard copies must be submitted to Eric Shorter, Director of Development, Rhode Island Housing, 44 Washington Street, Providence, RI 02903.
