South Approach Protective Coating and Steel Rehabilitation for the Mt. Hope Bridge

RITBA is soliciting proposals for qualified contractors to perform a rehabilitation on the south approach girder spans of the Mount Hope Bridge. The rehabilitation consists mainly of the blast cleaning of the superstructure and substructure structural steel, application of a new protective coating system in the same areas, and performing structural steel repairs in the same areas. The blasting and painting operations require complete containment of the affected areas. Steel repairs include known conditions and conditions discovered during the execution of the work. Other miscellaneous repair/rehabilitation items of work are included. Traffic control will be required.
