VACUUMED AND TACK-RAGGED IN PREPARATION FOR THE FIRST COAT OF
DISPERSED WATER FINISH

10) APPLY THE FIRST COAT OF WATER DISPERSED FINISH UTILIZING THE SAME METHOD
AS USED WITH THE SEALER COAT ABOVE ALLOW TO DRY COMPLETELY

11) ONCE AGAIN THE ENTIRE SURFACE SHOULD BE LIGHTLY MACHINE DISKED WITH
#100 OR #120 GRIT SCREENBACK UNDER A BUFFING OR POLISHING PAD AND FINALLY
VACUUMED AND TACK-RAGGED IN PREPARATION FOR COURT LAYOUT AND PAINTING

12) APPLY COURT LINING (AS SPECIFIED BY THE OWNER AT THE MANDATORY PRE-BID
MEETING) USING PAINT THAT IS COMPATIBLE WITH THE CHOSEN SEALER AND FINISH
(OWNER TO PROVIDE SELECTED PMS COLORS) MASK AND PAINT GAME LINES AND
WITH THE AID OF PRECISION TAPING MACHINES OR STRIPING TOOLS AFTER THE GAME
