Vendor Questions / State Responses:

1. Are the purchasing entity requesting quotes for armed or unarmed security officers?
(Unarmed)
2. Based on the geographical size of the Command Readiness Center and Camp Fogarty facilities, is a patrol vehicle(s) most likely necessary at each location in order to meet the patrol requirements and objectives. If so, does the procurement agency have any specific requirements, requests, or restrictions for patrol vehicles used?
(The only location that would need motorized patrol would be Camp Fogarty. A vehicle would be provided by the National Guard).
3. Upon a brief review of RI General Law § 28-6.5-1, it appears that random drug testing is not specifically provided for under the above law. As this is required under the RFP scope of work, we request additional clarification as to any other authorities which would control our ability to conduct random drug testing as required under the SOW.
(We expect all companies to abide by RI Gen Law§ 28-6.5-1).

4. The RFP requires officers to be trained in handcuffing procedures. As it appears from a brief review of Rhode Island law and the referenced RFP SOW, contracted officers would not be considered to be either peace officers as defined in RI General Law § 12-7-21 or officers of the RI National Guard as defined in RI General Law § 12-7-18. Therefore, we request further clarification regarding whether additional officer licensing or State of Rhode Island approval is required in order for officers to legally detain an individual through the use of handcuffing.

(As with private colleges and malls, providing that the individual is properly trained tactically and academically by a certified instructor, you may detain an individual until the proper authorities arrive. Upon award of a contract, the security guards may not be required by the National Guard to carry or use handcuffs; however they must be trained in handcuffing procedures and use of force in the case that it is implemented).

5. Is there any specific technology or equipment (computers, radios, guard tour *wands*, screening systems, etc) required to be provided by the contractor?

(None required, Radios, Guard Tour System, ID system and computers are provided by the National Guard).
