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

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

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

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Scope of work

The scope of work includes the removal, repair and installation of floats and gangways at the three (3) locations for a period of (5) years beginning with removal of materials in December 2011 and ending with installation of materials in April 2015. Condition of floatation should be assessed prior to removal of floats annually. Floatation failure will require replacement of entire float. All rollers replaced using stainless steel cotter pins(2) per roller.

With two(2) two (2) year options to renew. Condition of floatation should be assessed prior to removal of floats annually. Floatation failure will require replacement of entire float. All rollers replaced using stainless steel cotter pins(2) per roller.

Removal:

1. Flotation condition should be evaluated by contractor annually prior to removal. Removal of materials shall be removed each season by December 15 but not before December 1

2. Materials shall be stored in parking area adjacent to the boat ramp but not blocking as directed by DEM .

3. The floats shall be lifted and moved by fully supporting the weight of the floats with two (2) straps, cradles or other means. The contractor shall be liable for any damage to the floats resulting from improper handling.

4. Material shall be stored on level ground and floats stacked not more than two (2) high. All pile hoops ,cover plates and other hardware shall be delivered to RI DEM/ Division of Fish & Wildlife 277 Great Neck Rd West Kingston ,RI 02892 for winter storage.

Installation:

1. The materials shall be installed each spring by April 10th but no earlier than April 1st.

2. The floats shall only be lifted and moved by fully supporting the weight of the floats with two (2) straps , cradles or other approved means. The contractor shall be liable for any damage to the floats resulting from improper handling.

3. All bolts on cover plates and pile hoops shall be securely installed in the same location from which they were removed the previous season. The contractor shall arrange pickup with the RI DEM/ Division of Fish & Wildlife 277 Great Neck Rd West Kingston ,RI 02892 prior to installation.

Maintenance:

After the floats are removed each year, the contractor shall inspect each float for damage, wear and tear, decay, rot etc. and report findings to RI DEM/ Division of Fish & Wildlife 277 Great Neck Rd West Kingston ,RI 02892 .

Each spring, the vinyl rub rail shall be inspected by the contractor and Division of Fish & Wildlife representative. Damaged pieces shall be replaced by the contractor. Payment for vinyl rubrail shall be a per foot price set forth in the bid proposal with a minimum of twenty (20) feet replaced at one time except the ends of the floats where the minimum replaced shall be the entire width of the float (6 or 8 ft). Vinyl rubrail shall be anchored with stainless steel ring nails

spaced nine(9) inches on center and matching the existing rubrail in size, shape, material and color.

Each spring, at least on week before the floats are installed, the contractor shall remove all marine life from the floats by power washing and apply one coat of clear Cabot waterseal (or equal) to all sides of the pressure treated lumber. This application shall be done in the presenece of a Division of Fish & Wildlife employee. No waterseal product shall be applied to the composite decking. In addition, any rust that appears on the galvanized connections shall be removed and the connectors touched up with cold galvanizing

Each spring the composite decking shall be inspected by the contractor and Division of Fish & Wildlife. Damaged pieces shall be replaced by the contractor. Payment for composite decking shall be price per foot with the entire length of the composite deck board replaced six (6) or eight (8) ft as set in bid proposal. The new composite decking shall match the existing decking in size, color, and appearance. The composite decking shall be fastened to the stringers using stainless steel screws countersunk into the deck to match existing fasteners.

Each spring, the contractor shall replace miscellaneous fasteners (ie bolts, clips etc) as and rollers on pile hoops and cover plates as required. The fasteners shall be galvanized or stainless matching the existing hardware in type, diameter, length and head. Payment for fasteners shall be per each as set forth in the bid proposal. There is no minimum number of fasteners to be replaced.
