MARKED CRUISER EMERGENCY LIGHTING PACKAGE
FOR
2012 CHEVROLET CAPRICE PATROL VEHICLES

The Department of Administration Division of Purchases, on behalf of the Rhode Island State Police, is soliciting price proposals to furnish and/or install emergency lighting equipment as identified in the attached scope of work relating to marked cruiser emergency lighting packages. The emergency packages will be installed on 2012 Chevrolet Caprice Patrol Vehicles.

All installations shall include all necessary cabling, parts and connectors needed. No substitutions to the specified equipment shall be permitted with the prior written approval of the Rhode Island State Police. All emergency equipment will be installed as specified in the vehicle manufacturer's OEM up-fitters guide for the current model year.

The Rhode Island State Police will be soliciting for twenty (20) 2012 Chevrolet Caprice Patrol Vehicles which will be drop shipped to the awarded light package provider.

POLICE RADIO(S): Install one (1) Department supplied radio with antenna. The location is to be determined by Fleet Administrator.

SIREN/LIGHT CONTROL SYSTEM

A Whelen model CAN2 Control Siren and light control system or approved Department equal shall be furnished and installed. The siren shall be a two piece remote system utilizing a slide lever switch and membrane push button switches to control the warning lights. The siren system must be fully programmable using a PC application. The system shall provide direct control of the lightbar without the use of an interface device. The system shall provide at least eight programmable inputs and nineteen programmable outputs to provide automatic control of various light systems in the vehicle. The switching layout and program must be approved by the fleet section. A Whelen model SA315P siren speaker or Department approved equal shall be furnished and installed using appropriate vehicle specific mounting brackets.

LIGHTBAR

A Whelen model SR8RRRR-RISP or Department approved equal shall be furnished and installed. The lightbar shall contain at least fourteen high intensity individually replaceable LED modules capable of emitting light at extremely wide viewing angles to provide adequate warning in all directions. The rear inboard modules shall be capable of illuminating in dual colors; red or amber. The lightbar control system shall have the ability to control these rear modules individually for complete control and functionality. The rear of the lightbar should have the ability to simultaneously flash from red to amber in the "auxiliary" flash mode while the vehicle is

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in park. The lightbar shall also include high intensity LED takedown and alley lights that are capable of being switched independently and also able to flash with the warning lights. The lightbar should have the ability to automatically turn off the driver's side takedown light and front corner module when the driver's door is opened to avoid distracting the vehicle operator. The lightbar shall incorporate an automatic photocell that will put the lightbar into low power mode only at nighttime and when the vehicle is stopped. In addition the lightbar shall automatically change to an "auxiliary" flash pattern when the vehicle is stopped. This auxiliary pattern must be approved by the fleet section. The lightbar must conform to SAE Class 1 light output standards, even in low power mode. The lightbar shall also be covered by a ten year warranty on all electronic parts and light modules. Two Whelen model AVNS2RR/RR or Department approved equal shall be installed on the rear deck. The lights shall be capable of being synchronized without the use of an external flasher. A red/red unit shall be installed on the driver's side rear deck and a red/red unit installed on the passenger's side rear deck. These lights shall automatically turn off when the vehicle is shifted into park with the ability to turn them back on using a button on the siren control panel.

Console

- A Havis-Shields Model RISP-VS-CAPR Package Console model specific or Department approved equal shall be furnished and installed in each vehicle. The console shall be constructed of steel to provide strength and durability. The top of the console should consist of two aluminum extrusions with captured mounting nuts to facilitate easy adjustment of equipment brackets, microphone brackets and other console mounted accessories. A Pentax printer USB cable(6ft) and printer hardwire power cord with an eight position blade type fuse panel shall be included. All console mounted control heads will be connected to this panel. All required mounting hardware and equipment specific brackets and microphone clips and bracket will be included with the console.

HEADLIGHT FLASHER

Install Whelen headlight flasher #SSFPOS or Department approved equal

TAIL LAMP LEDS

Two Whelen VTX609C Super LED lamps or Department approved equal shall be installed in the rear tail lamps. The exact location of these lights shall be confirmed by the fleet section prior to installation.

Reverse Light LEDS

Two Whelen VTX609C Super LED lamps or Department approved equal shall be installed in the reverse lights. The exact location of these lights shall be confirmed by the fleet section prior to installation

Anti-theft system

REFERENCE: Tremco model 030. With lifetime warranty.

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Push bumper

REFERENCE: Setina Aluminum model # PB450L4P – Whelen LINZ6 (RR) with five (5) year warranty on parts, labor, and finish of bumper and seven (7) year warranty on lights or Department approved equal.

Trunk Flashers

Two (2) Whelen 5SR00FRR LED lights mounted on inside of trunk lid to operate when trunk is open (on separate fused circuits).

Shotgun Rack

REFERENCE: Big Sky Racks Inc. Model ELS 210 installed with the trunk lid mount or Department approved equal.

First Aid Kit

Dyna Med Trunk First Aid Kit #TK042, or Department approved equal.

DELIVERY:

- Pre-delivery, the vehicle shall be serviced and inspected by the emergency package vendor. The emergency package vendor shall be responsible for the complete new vehicle delivery inspection. The engine, transmission, differential and cooling system shall be filled to the manufacturer's recommended capacity and the gas tank filled to capacity prior to delivery. The vehicle will receive a new vehicle cleaning and preparation prior to delivery. All equipment shall be completely installed and adjustments made prior to delivery to make this vehicle available for immediate use. The vehicle shall be free of any defects when delivered.
- A representative from the Rhode Island State Police will inspect the vehicle at delivery for workmanship and appearance before acceptance.
- If any deficiencies are observed and cannot be corrected within two (2) business days, the vehicle will be deleted from the invoice and payment will not be made until corrective action is taken and the vehicle is re-inspected and accepted. It shall be the responsibility of the vendor for the pickup and delivery of the vehicle for re-inspection.

- It will be the responsibility of the emergency package vendor to transport the vehicle from the emergency package vendor's location to the delivery destination. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

AN INSURANCE CERTIFICATE IN COMPLIANCE WITH PROVISIONS OF ITEM 31 (INSURANCE) OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE IS REQUIRED FOR COMPREHENSIVE GENERAL LIABILITY, AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY, AND WORKERS' COMPENSATION AND MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER(S) TO THE DIVISION OF PURCHASES PRIOR TO AWARD. THE INSURANCE CERTIFICATE MUST NAME THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND AS CERTIFICATE HOLDER AND AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE PROVISIONS MAY RESULT IN REJECTION OF THE OFFEROR'S BID.
