



If the fire alarm system is activated or fire is discovered in the home, the following procedure must be followed:


- 1. Immediately evacuate the residents from the home or building.**
- 2. Evacuate the home or building using planned escape routes or alternate escape routes if necessary.**
- 3. Never stop to retrieve clothing or other valuables.**
- 4. Evacuate multi-handicapped and those nearest the problem area first.**
- 5. Leave the home or building only after the residents have been evacuated.**
- 6. Meet or assemble at the determined meeting place and account for all residents. Meeting place is: All residents are to meet at the end of the tree in the athletic field parking lot/driveway.**
- 7. Call the Fire Department as soon as possible from the outside of the home or building (i.e. by using a neighbor's phone or cell phone).**
- 8. Never re-enter the home or building, unless authorized by the Fire Department.**
- 9. Stay calm as to not excite the individuals.**
- 10. All statements to the media should be made by the Director or in that person's absence, the Assistant Director or Department Heads.**

BID STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THIS BID

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PRICING AGREEMENT

SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS - This Agreement covers requirements as described herein, ordered by State agencies during the Agreement Period. No additional or alternative requirements are covered, unless added to the Agreement by formal amendment by the State Purchasing Agent or his designee.

Under State Purchasing Law, 37-2-54, no purchase or contract shall be binding on the state or any agency thereof unless approved by the department [of administration] or made under general regulations which the chief purchasing officer may prescribe. Under State Purchasing Regulation 8 2 1 1 2, any alleged oral agreement or arrangements made by a bidder or contractor with any agency or an employee of the Office of Purchases may be disregarded and shall not be binding on the state

PRODUCT ACCEPTANCE - All merchandise offered or otherwise provided shall be new, of prime manufacture, and of first quality unless otherwise specified by the State. The State reserves the right to reject all nonconforming goods, and to cause their return for credit or replacement, at the State's option

- a) Failure by the state to discover latent defect(s) or concealed damage or non-conformance shall not foreclose the State's right to subsequently reject the goods in question
- b) Formal or informal acceptance by the State of non-conforming goods shall not constitute a precedent for successive receipts or procurements

Where the vendor fails to cure the defect promptly or replace the goods, the State reserves the right to cancel the Release, contract with a different vendor, and to invoice the original vendor for any differential in price over the original contract price

ORDER AUTHORIZATION AND RELEASE AGAINST PRICING AGREEMENT
