Title: Drug & Alcohol Testing (C.D.L.) – MPA # 220

1. Can you please provide the addresses (or zip codes) for where the mobile unit and/or collection facilities, need to be provided to complete your testing needs?  
*Answer: Locations for RIDOT and RIDEM are contained within this addendum. Other locations will be posted at a later date..*
  
  2. The mobile collection unit pricing is premised on the frequency, # of donors at a time, and location of your facilities, on a monthly or quarterly basis. Can you please provide specifics for this need?  
Mobile collections are based upon the number of employees being tested at a rate of 50% annually. State personnel may be employed at any of the locations specified in response #1. The number of donors tested at a time is dependent upon the actual random selection. For example, if four (4) personnel from one job location are randomly selected, then we would make an effort to test all four on the same day.  
*Answer: Currently, we test on a quarterly basis. If a vendor prefers or recommends (for cause) to perform testing on a monthly basis, we may consider a monthly process.*
  
  3. **On Page 6 of the RFP, it asks for "Blind Sample Requirements." Our blind sample program works according to the Federal Regulations of the DOT. I have attached the most recent regulations for blind specimen testing to this email. After review of the regulations and according to your anticipated volume of your testing program, you would not qualify for this need. Please let us know how to proceed in relation to this topic.**  
*Answer: The blind sample requirements utilized at the laboratory where a vendor sends their samples for testing is required; it can be as simple as submitting the regulations and responding to the question as you did above.*
  
  4. To minimize the amount of documentation you receive, can the Cost proposal be included as a subsection of the technical proposal? Otherwise, if we have to submit an original and 5 copies, there will be a total of 12 separate pieces in the envelope, and I thought it may be more convenient for you to have a total of 6 pieces, of which contain all the requested information organized and chaptered by a "Table of Contents"  
*Answer: Yes. Costs may be submitted as part of the tech proposal.*
