Glass & Glazing – Doors, Frames & Hardware Scope of Work

December 17, 2012

DESCRIPTION: The Department of Administration Division of Facilities Management is in the process of renovating the Department of Administration's offices located on the 4th floor of the Powers Building in Providence, Rhode Island. The scope of this project includes the demolition of certain drywall partitions and the construction of new drywall partitions in this area. All of the current MEP (HVCA, Electrical, Telephone / Data, and Sprinkler) systems require modifications to meet the proposed layout for this area. The area of work will be broken down into two (2) phases; phase 1 work will occur immediately and phase 2 is anticipated to start directly after the phase 1 work is complete. The current occupant in the phase 2 area needs to be relocated in the building.

The building is fully occupied and the Glass & Glazing subcontractor will be allowed to work normal working hours with the exception of any activities that generate excessive noise and will interfere with the ongoing business of the building occupants. The Glass & Glazing subcontractor will be required to coordinate all of his work with the Division of Facilities Management's Project Manager and may have to work off hours to complete noise generating activities. The subcontractor shall include the cost of any required overtime or premium time in his bid. The owner will not reimburse the subcontractor for any overtime or premium time to complete the project.

SCOPE OF WORK: The work of this bid package shall include the following items:

- 1) Furnish and install the three (3) Aluminum Storefront Frames including all doors, windows, glass, glazing and hardware for a complete installation.
- 2) The Aluminum Store Frames shall match the other aluminum frames in this area for color, size and profile.
- 3) The glass and glazing subcontractor will provide any blocking or other materials required to anchor the frames to the structure.
- 4) This subcontractor will furnish to the owner all hollow metal frames, prefinished wood doors, and hardware as indicated on the contract documents.
- 5) Please see the attached Sketch SKA-1 dated 11-27-12 for changes to the door – hardware schedule.
- 6) Please delete all work associated with doors no. 108 and 118.
- 7) Prefinished doors shall be Grade A Sliced Honduras Mahogany Standard Factory Finish.
- 8) All Hollow Metal Doors Frames shall be knocked down construction.
- 9) All Doors shall be provided with construction cylinders along with cylinders to be keyed by the owner's locksmith.
- 10) Please refer to Sketch SKA-1 for doors that will require card readers with electric strikes.

- 11) Furnish and install One (1) additional electric door strike for an existing glass and aluminum frame on the third floor
- 12) Hardware to be as follows:
 - a. Hinges: Ives 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" x 10B butt hinges
 - b. Closers: LCN4111 EDA w/cover
 - c. Lock: Schlage ND53PD x 10B lockset
 - d. Flush Bolt: Ives 458 x 10B Flush Bolts (for inactive leaf on pair of doors)
 - e. Exist Device: Sargent 8813F x 713ETL x 10B rim exit device
 - f. Silencers: three (3) per door frame
- 13) All doors, frames and hardware shall be F.O.B. to the project site.
- 14) All Hollow Metal Knock Down Frames shall be delivered to the project site no later than 1/11/13.
- 15) Provide a new door frame for door no. 117

SURETY

BIDDER IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A BID SURETY IN THE FORM OF A BID BOND, OR A CERTIFIED CHECK PAYABLE TO THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND IN THE AMOUNT OF A SUM NOT LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT (5%) OF THE BID PRICE. BID SURETY MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE BID FORM. THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER WILL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO FURNISH PERFORMANCE AND LABOR AND PAYMENT BONDS AT TIME OF TENTATIVE CONTRACT AWARD.
