Enclosed is your final authorization to discharge storm water associated with construction activity under the Rhode Island Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (RIPDES) Program. The Authorization to Discharge should be attached to your copy of the 2008 RIPDES General Permit for Storm Water Discharge Associated with Construction Activity (2008 Construction General Permit, which you already have on file), and be kept on-site as verification of authorization to discharge. All terms and conditions outlined in the 2008 Construction General Permit must be met. Any permit non-compliance constitutes a violation of Chapter 46-12 of the Rhode Island General Laws of 1956, as amended, and is grounds for enforcement. For future references and inquiry, your permit authorization number is RIPDES No. **RIR101020**.

Prior to the initiation of construction, RIDEM requests that a copy of the finalized and signed copy of the SWPPP be submitted to the RIPDES Program for the permit record.
