The State's Contractor shall adjust all electric manholes per the plans and specifications using an NGRID approved subcontractor and as directed by the Engineer. If manhole covers are to be temporarily covered by earth or asphalt, the cover shall be located by NGRID with ties to three fixed objects prior to covering the manhole. The manhole cover location shall be marked by paint or stakes by the Contractor after it is covered. All manhole covers shall be uncovered and fully exposed within 24 hours after being covered.

NGRID – GAS

The existing gas facilities are sensitive to ground vibrations and heavy equipment loads. A Gas Company Representative shall be present during construction in and around these facilities.

If gas lines become exposed during construction operations, NGRID shall be called (508-421-7465 or 7466) to inspect the lines before they are backfilled.

The State's Contractor shall adjust and/or replace valve covers per the plans and specifications and as directed by the Engineer, and install the following gas mains or protective plates using a NGRID approved subcontractor in accordance with the contract plans and specifications;

- A. South Main Street: Sta. 881+70 to Wickenden St. Sta. 63+70 – 8 inch plastic main and appurtenances. Remove and dispose existing 6 inch cast iron main.

The work includes but is not limited to bituminous pavement, sidewalk construction, granite curbing, drainage, utilities (water, sewer, gas, electric, telephone, CATV), coordinating the installation of utilities by several utility companies, pavement marking, signing, traffic signals, lighting conduit and foundations, landscaping, urban design elements, pavement removal, excavation, hauling, grading, removal and disposal of concrete footings, removing, restoration and resetting steel picket fence, 2 bar steel bridge rail, remove and reset monument, and various architectural masonry and metals. Incidental construction includes site preparation, plantable soil and seed, maintenance and protection of traffic including detours and temporary closures, rubble riverwall restoration, dewatering and treatment of groundwater, handling and disposal of contaminated soil, erosion controls, and all other incidentals, complete and accepted within the project.

The Contractor will be required, in accordance with the provisions of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Affirmative Action Certification for Contractors and Consultants, to meet the established Race-Conscious Goal, or Contract Goal, of not less than 10.00 percent of the contract bid price, to the Contractors, Subcontractors, and/or suppliers which qualify as Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's).
