RFQ 7461364- DUNE GRASS FOR STATE BEACHES

The Rhode Island State beaches lost many established dunes from the tidal surges and winds of Hurricane Sandy. It is essential to reestablish and maintain the physical barriers which manage the surface movement of shifting coastal beach sands.

Reestablishing the system of coastal sand dunes help to protect human lives, personal property, and established beach structures. A secondary benefit of such developments is the creation and protection of critical habitat of threatened and endangered bird species.

Beachgrass is successional classified as a pioneering type species; it is about the only species capable of surviving the harsh environmental conditions of the frontal dunes. For initially stabilizing a dune system, this species is the most reliable and commercially available option. Once established it rapidly spreads by a rhizomatous root system, developing a soil binding network of inter-woven roots.

***522,000 cones/culms of 'Cape' american beachgrass (*Ammophila breveligulata*)**

Each cone/culms is to be 6" to 10" in height and healthy

Delivery

Due to the survival and effective planting season of the product, delivery must be before April 20, 2013 to allow effective planting before May 1, 2013.

Due to the shortage of American Beach grass and potential lack of the product to the market, delivery will also be accepted after October 1, 2013 to allow for an alternative planting season from Nov 1 through Dec 1. **OR** arrangements can be made for spring 2014 delivery.
