

The installation or the new wall structure shall begin five working days after award of a Purchase Order. All restorations of grounds surrounding the project shall be completed by the contractor. Overtime hours are the responsibility of the contractors' base bid to meet project schedule. Contractor shall submit a schedule for approval of the College. Contractor shall submit a engineered set of design build plans to be approved by the State Building Committee and submitted to RIC after approval.

#### LICENSING

1.5 : Laws, Permits. Contractor shall comply with all applicable federal and state laws, regulations and codes. Contractor shall be licensed with the RI Contractors Registration Board. All bonds and insurances shall be required and included in the bid package. Contractor shall be current with all OSHA certifications and will provide copies to RIC.

#### 1.6 Scope of work:

Provide material, labor, equipment and supervision to design/build the segmental retaining wall reference above, the estimated wall is 375 linear feet with an average height of 6.5 feet of exposed wall not including embedment.

The block color and texture selected by Rhode Island College is Grey Color/Splitface texture

Proposals to include the work described for the segmented block wall:

- The Versa-Lok standard System is to be utilized.
- Furnish and install the SRW retaining wall units and caps.
- Level 6" base/leveling pad using dense graded crushed stone.
- Furnish and install the geo-grid reinforcements.
- Spread and compact the suitable retaining wall backfill within the reinforced zone.
- Engineering design, shop drawings, required submittals and construction drawings signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer.
- Furnish and install a minimum 4" drain pipe.
- Install the ¾" minus unit core fill and wall drainage fill.
- All insurances as required by bid documents
- Labor
- Machinery
- Safety requirements i.e. (OSHA fall protection)

- 1.8 **Estimated Soil Conditions and Design** : The following estimated soil conditions qualify the geogrid reinforcements. If the soil parameters change due to subsequent site specific testing the quantities will need to be adjusted. If an increase is required in regards to the geogrid quantities due to changes in soil parameters a change order will require approval by RIC personnel.

Reinforced Fill (geogrid zone)

34 friction angle and 130 PCF unit weight

Retained Soils

34 friction angle and 130 PCF unit weight

Foundation Soils

34 friction angle and 130 PCF unit weight

Groundwater

If the provided geotechnical soil borings indicate groundwater within the wall influence, this information will be utilized and included in the proposal. If groundwater is found to be at varying elevations or previous unknown locations, the geogrid quantities included in this proposal will change. Any increase due to unknown groundwater elevations or locations will require a change order and RIC approval prior to proceeding with work.

**Include** : Proposals are to include the following items and/or work to be performed:

- **LEVELING PAD AND CORE FILL GRAVEL**

Furnishing suitable ¾" or #57 clean crushed stone for block cores and wall drainage fill

Furnishing suitable dense graded crushed stone for wall leveling pad(s).

- **EXCAVATION**

Excavate Approximately 375' x 6.5' X 18' Deep remove off site Trench for new wall. Install 1" ¾" Stone for base.

Install 8" processed gravel where roadway will be made wider, compact and fine grade.

- **BACKFILL MATERIALS**

Backfill wall in lifts per specification with processed material.

Install 375' precast curb, Install 2.5" binder, 1.5" (Class). There will be a 3' bed in front wall.

The provided retaining wall backfill shall meet the minimum requirements listed in the estimated soil parameters listed above as well as additional backfill that may be required. The reinforced material will be delivered at a moisture content within 3% of optimum moisture.

All soil testing as it pertains to the reinforced fill, retained fill and the foundation soils shall be performed prior to commencement of the work and throughout the construction process.

Backfill materials shall either be placed directly behind the reinforced zone of the retaining wall or as agreed upon by the field representative.

The retained fill behind the reinforced zone shall be placed by other in unison with the placement of the reinforced soils. The coordination of the lifts shall take place on the project by the firm's site representative and the contractor in charge of the placement of the retained fill. i.e. (Excavation Contractor).

Paint lines as needed.

- TESTING AND INSPECTIONS

Testing and Inspections will be performed by independent agent hired by Rhode Island College.

- LAYOUT/STAKING

Establishment of retaining wall lines and grades and effects will be performed shall be included in the proposal. The layout shall establish front face of walls, elevations, PC, PT, and ends of walls; radius stakes every 10' and stationing staking every 50' or closer if required by site constraints.

- SHORING

Providing all necessary shoring for existing structures and excavations per OSHA.

- ACCESSABILITY

The owner or grading contractor will provide all-weather accessibility to work and material storage areas. Access shall accommodate any equipment required to construct the retaining walls. The all-weather access will be maintained throughout wall construction by the owner.

- SAFETY FENCE

Installing and maintaining temporary and permanent safety fencing along the top of wall is shall be included in the proposal.

- PERMITS

Any and all necessary permits that are required for the construction of the retaining wall are to be included in the proposal.
