WORK: Repair of Residential/Commercial/Recreational structures as a result of **Post-Tropical Storm Sandy, October 29, 2012**, that are not damaged beyond maintenance as defined by Section 300.14 of the RICRMP.

EMERGENCY GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS:

1. The footprint or outside dimensions of the renovated structures may not exceed the footprint or outside dimension of the original structure.
2. The total square footage of the renovated structure cannot exceed the pre-renovation square footage.
3. The work must comply with all local zoning and building codes. All necessary permits must be obtained from any and all other local, state or federal governmental entities which may have jurisdiction over the area.
4. All fill materials shall be clean, free of debris and rubble, and free of materials which may cause pollution of surface waters or groundwater.
5. All areas of exposed soil which are disturbed by construction and related activities shall be revegetated as immediately as is physically possible so as to minimize erosion and sedimentation. If the season is not conducive to immediate revegetation, all exposed soils shall be temporarily stabilized with hay mulch or similar material. Soil stabilization methods shall be employed during, as well as after, the construction phase to the maximum extent possible.
6. The standards and specifications set forth in the most recent RI Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook shall be strictly adhered to.
7. Repair of damaged residential, commercial or recreational structure served by an Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (OWTS) may require a DEM OWTS Suitability Determination pursuant to DEM OWTS Rule 17, if the septic system (or any components) were installed without DEM approval or installed prior to April 9, 1968. Contact your local building official and DEM OWTS (401-222-6820).
8. Repair of damaged Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (OWTS) requires a DEM OWTS permit. You must obtain the DEM OWTS permit first, and then submit a copy with CRMC application for Assent.

ALL WORK MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN NINETY (90) DAYS OF THE INSPECTION OF THIS EMERGENCY PERMIT.
