1. Prebid Conference

2. Bidder Questions

3. Project Inspections

Project inspection will be by the RIDOT Resident Engineer, the South Kingstown Building, Fire District, and Wastewater Officials, and United Water.

4. Town Permits

Contractor is responsible to secure and pay all charges, fees, and taxes for all building, fire review, and sewer permits from the Town of South Kingstown. All costs for securing permits shall be included in the unit prices bid for the various items of the Contract.

5. RIDEM Permit Tolloed

There is a RIDEM Freshwater Wetlands Insignificant Alteration – Revised Permit in effect for this Contract. Per the Tolling Statute, Rhode Island General Law 42-17.1-2.5, amended June 25, 2013, the new expiration date for the permit is October 25, 2015.
