**Title: SAKAI ON LINE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, UNIVERSITY OF RHODE ISLAND**

B.2 - Describe how your company monitors stability of Sakai tools, course sites and project sites.

Question: Are you referring to the tools stability only and what is the QA process for new tools?

**ANSWER:** We are referring to not only the overall system performance but stability of an individual tool, course site and project site while it is in a LIVE production environment. Providing a description of the QA process for new tools will be useful additional information but by itself will not answer the question.

B.6 - Describe your ability to accommodate a complete array of Sakai Learning Management System services, summarize the depth of breadth of those services.

Question: Are you referring to third party/LTI plugin tools?

**ANSWER:** We are referring to third party/LTI plugin tools, Sakai core tools, non-core Sakai tools referred to as 'contrib' tools and shown at <https://confluence.sakaiproject.org> and <https://source.sakaiproject.org>, and other third party tools not hosted by [sakaiproject.org](http://sakaiproject.org), such as the JForum contrib tool from Etudes, available at <http://etudes.org>.

B.7 - Describe how other versions of Sakai which you provide to other institutions can impact, if at all, the performance or delivery of the URI Sakai LMS?

Question: Can we get clarification if this is for development and development delays vs. hosting/execution environment "cross-talk".

**ANSWER:** This is hosting/execution environment "cross-talk". We need you to explain how your hosting environment works so as to ensure that URI's instance of Sakai is not impacted by versions, issues, data problems or even a security breach in one instance: how is the URI instance impacted or protected from these issues?
