- 1) Would it be possible to receive a copy of the inventory in an Excel spreadsheet?
Yes. Current updated inventory is attached. (Some do not match with what you have)
- 2) The inventory includes unknown materials, how would you like those quoted?
Unknowns are case by case depending on analytical sampling and the results
If you can, describe how you analyze them with estimated price.
- 3) Would it be possible to get the activity for all material on the inventory?
For chemical compound, I can update weight when weather gets better.
Other waste are very close to what I know (listed on Excel sheet). Metal and dry waste are estimates.
- 4) What is the soil contaminated with?
According to historical data and gamma spec, mainly U and Th series with Cs-137.
- 5) Would it be possible to extend the due date? The responses will be given by 2/27/15, two days before the deadline. Based on the information requested it would not be possible to complete the bid by March 4th deadline.
Yes. We can extend the due date.
- 6) Unknowns are case by case and require analysis. How would you like to see the unknown metal disks quoted?
Unknown metal means we don't know what types of metal except a couple of contaminated materials. Almost all metal waste were activated materials.
- 7) What are the chemical constituents of the unquenched standards?
Don't know. I assume toluene base.
- 8) Please provide MSDS for scintillation cocktail
I don't think I have that. As you know most of them are pretty old and I thought almost all unquenched standard are toluene base based on my experience. If this is very important for you guys to find out rather than treated as flammable toluene, we can try to spend a day to find out but as said, I cannot guarantee we will find all the MSDS
