

SANDBLAST AND PAINT DUMP TRUCK BODIES

The Rhode Island Department of Administration/Division of Purchases, on behalf of the Department of Transportation (RIDOT) Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division, is soliciting bid proposals to sandblast and paint the dump truck bodies of approximately 17 of its 2007 Mack fleet of six wheel and ten wheel dump trucks which have experienced some rot and/or rust damage due to exposure to corrosive chemicals (salt, calcium, brine) during winter operations.

In order to maintain the structural integrity, and prolong the useful life of these vehicles, refinishing of these exterior surfaces will be necessary. This shall consist of, but not be limited to, sandblasting, renew/replacement of steel sections/components (welding), priming, painting, and detailed cleaning.

To accomplish the above, the following specifications must be adhered to:

1. Sandblast and paint inside and outside, bottom rear ends, frame rails (in and out), plow frames, wing towers, fuel tanks, hydraulic tanks.
2. Prime and paint with DUPONT #400-01 Black (4 mils), DUPONT #681-709 Industrial Sealer (2 mils) and DUPONT white (4 mils).
3. Sandblast and paint wheel rims (DUPONT gray). Wheels will be removed by RIDOT; tires will not be removed from the rims for painting.
4. Buff out cab and clean interior.
5. Vehicles will be delivered to the awarded vendor's facility.
6. Plows will be removed prior to delivery.
7. Sandblasting must be done in accordance with "Steel Structures Painting Council (SSPC SP-10)"

.The successful vendor must have a facility that will safely store vehicles in a locked and protected area. Trucks must be sandblasted inside blasting booth, and painting must be performed in a closed paint booth large enough to accommodate the truck size. It is expected the vendor will complete two trucks per month

(d) Bids for single items and/or a small percentage of total items listed, may, at the State's sole option, be rejected as being non-responsive to the intent of this request. ORDERING (a) The User Agency(s) will submit individual orders for the various items and various quantities as may be required during the agreement period. (b) Exception - Regardless of any agreement resulting from this bid, the State reserves the right to solicit prices separately for any extra large requirements for delivery to specific destinations.
