Questions for the Rhode Island Institution RFP #7549588

1. What is the average sentence of a sex offender in Rhode Island? As of 3/31/15 there were a total of 365 inmates at the Adult Correctional Institutions (ACI) sentenced on sex offender charges. Five (5) offenders were sentenced to serve life without parole and 21 offenders to life with the possibility of parole. For those offenders to a term to serve, the average length was about 15 years.
2. It is noted that there is an 84 bed unit for sex offenders at the Moran medium facility. What is the average stay of an inmate in this unit? There is no average length of stay for this unit. Inmates are allowed to leave the program when they choose or to stay until they are released. Is their placement in that unit related to their sex offender risk level and/or time to projected release date? There is a mandatory 30 day session for all sex offenders, at the end of which they can leave and return to general population of meet specific criteria and stay enrolled in the program. Are they released from that unit to the community or are they returned to general population upon completion? Both
3. There are approximately 400 sex offenders in the R.I. DOC. Do you have Static 99R scores on all of these offenders? Static 99R scores are available for some but not all offenders.
4. How many of the convicted sex offenders in the Rhode Island DOC are female? Of the 365 sentenced sex offenders at the ACI, one (1) was female.
5. Sex offender management programs (groups) must be provided to sex offenders in the maximum security facility (up to 25 male inmates) (up to 5 female inmates). What is the total number of male and female offenders in maximum security? Sixty-two (62) male sex offenders were housed in maximum security while the 1 female offender was housed in the Gloria McDonald Awaiting Trial and Medium Security Facility.
