The Rhode Island 1663 Colonial Charter is currently housed in a metal and concrete safe dating to c. 1915. In 2013, the safe was moved from the second floor of the State House to the newly-constructed Colonial Charter Museum on the first floor. In 2014, funding was secured to construct a new encasement system to house the Charter, which will provide a more optimal preservation environment for the document. The existing safe must be removed from the Rhode Island State House in Providence, R.I. and transported to an alternate State-owned facility in Providence, R.I.

The safe is presently located on the first floor of the State House, in the Colonial Charter Museum (Room 143), in the Northeast corridor of the building.

The approximate dimensions & weight of the Charter Safe are:

- 98" (h) x 53" (w) x 30" (d)
- 6,000 pounds (3 tons)

The Rhode Island Department of State is seeking qualified rigging companies to remove the Colonial Charter Safe from the Rhode Island State House Colonial Charter Museum and deliver to the Cranston Street Armory, 123 Dexter Ave, Providence, RI. The safe will be offloaded in the basement garage under the Armory. The garage has a garage door entrance accessible from the Parade Street entrance to the building.

Vendors must demonstrate proof of liability, workers compensation, and property insurances and provide (3) references for experience with moving large objects in historical buildings. The marble floors in the State House date to 1900, and cannot be damaged in any way during the moving process, as they cannot be replaced. If such damage occurs, Vendor assumes all liability.

Vendors should note that the timely completion of this project is of paramount importance to the State. In addition to a project fee, vendors must provide documentation that confirms availability to perform these services on the date(s) proposed by the Department of State. Though price will ultimately be the determining factor in selecting the awarded vendor, the Department of State reserves the right to reject any proposal that cannot accommodate the specified schedule.

Anticipated Project Tasks:

Work will take place in a single day, and will occur on a Saturday to minimize the impact on normal business operations at the State House. The anticipated date for this service is Saturday, July 25, 2015.

1. *Removal of Safe of Charter Museum:*

Doors to the safe shall be removed to allow for the unit to fit through the 36" doorway to the Charter Museum. The door to the museum shall be removed in advance. Safe shall be moved from the Charter Museum into the corridor, approximately 14.16 feet (170").

2. *Transport of Safe from Corridor to Truck:*

The safe will be moved down the marble corridor to the main staircase at the North entrance of the State House. The safe must be moved down a set of stairs in order to be removed from the building. The approximate distance safe must travel from the Museum entrance top of the staircase at the North Entrance is: 96 feet (1,152"). There are 8 stairs (7 risers) over a distance of 7 1/2' feet (91"). The staircase measures 10.16 feet (122") wide. Once at the bottom of the staircase, the safe must be moved an additional 20 feet (240") (+/-) to the door. The door at the North entrance measures 82" wide.

Estimated Total Distance: 138 feet

3. *Transportation, Unloading, and re-assembly at Cranston Street Armory :*

- a. The safe shall be loaded onto Vendor's truck and transported to the Cranston Street Armory, located at 123 Dexter Street, Providence, RI 02909. The estimated travel distance is approximately 3.0 miles.
- b. Upon arrival at the Cranston Street Armory, Vendor will unload the safe and will re-install the safe doors on the unit.




Photo of current condition of Charter Safe.


