Per the issuance of Department of Transportation ADDENDUM # 7550287A2 the following changes are noted:

- **CORRECTION**

It has been determined that the successful 6/10 Preliminary Engineering TEAM – Prime and Sub-Consultant(s) **WILL BE PRECLUDED** from participating on the future 6/10 Design-Build Project.

- **REVISION**

- On Page 1 of RFP, RIDOT has **REVISED** the last statement in 2<sup>nd</sup> Paragraph which states “*This project will have an approved 30% DESIGN completed.*” as follows:

***This Project will advance the preferred alternative’s design to a level acceptable to RIDOT for a Design-Build solicitation.***

- **DELETION/ ADDITION:**

- In Project Scope, the Introductory Paragraph cited “**PROJECT OVERVIEW**”, please **DELETE** the following statement:

~~*This project will have an approved 30% design completed.*~~

And **ADD** the following replacement statement:

***“The PE Consultant will perform the engineering necessary to evaluate alternatives through the NEPA process and to advance a preferred alternative to an environmental document (FONSI/ROD). This effort will begin with sketch-level alternative layouts during the beginning stages of NEPA. As the alternatives are narrowed through the NEPA process, the level of engineering is expected to increase. For these stages the PE Consultant will be expected to complete engineering efforts to the level necessary to obtain an environmental document (FONSI/ROD). Once a preferred alternative is identified, the PE Consultant will advance the preferred alternative’s design to a level appropriate for a Design-Build solicitation.”***

- In Project Scope of Work, under "**PROJECT OVERVIEW**" Section, please **ADD** the following as "new" *Third Paragraph* under this Section:

*"The overall intent of this effort is to provide engineering support to identify a preferred alternative through the NEPA process, obtain a FONSI/ROD for that alternative, and then advance the preferred alternative's design to a level acceptable to RIDOT for a Design-Build solicitation. The following Tasks, Work Elements and Deliverables are illustrative of the potential work that may be necessary to achieve this effort's intent. It is not guaranteed each stated deliverable will be required, as it will be determined based on the NEPA document's needs".*

- In Project Scope of Work, under "**TASK 1- Project Management and Administration**", the following **SUB-TASK 1.6** is hereby **ADDED** to the "Work Elements" listing:

*"1.6 - Coordination with NEPA Consultant - The PE Consultant will be expected to coordinate with the NEPA Consultant to obtain all information necessary to provide the level of design services needed to advance the Project. The PE Consultant will perform the engineering services needed as identified by the NEPA Consultant."*

- In Project Scope of Work, under "**TASK 4- Preliminary Engineering**", under **TASK 4 Objectives**, please **DELETE** the following objective cited:

➤ ~~Advance preferred alternative conceptual layout developed during NEPA phase to a 30% design level~~

And **REPLACE** with the following:

➤ *Advance preferred alternative conceptual layout developed during the NEPA Phase to a level of design acceptable to RIDOT for a Design-Build solicitation.*

- In Project Scope of Work, under "**TASK 4- Preliminary Engineering**", under **TASK 4 Deliverables**, please **DELETE** the following deliverable cited:

➤ ~~Preliminary Design Submission (30%)~~

And **REPLACE** with the following:

➤ *Preliminary Design Submission*

#### **TO ALL RESPONDENTS:**

- Respondents are instructed to submit a combined **LETTER OF INTEREST/ TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**. Information requested should be limited to requirements cited in RFP in line with the project **SELECTION CRITERIA**.
- RIDOT anticipates the award of **ONE (1) CONTRACT** that will have a completion date of **24 MONTHS** after issuance of Notice to Proceed.
- Project will be **100% STATE FUNDED** therefore per RIDOT policy, the **125% OH CAP** will be imposed so
- **CONFLICT OF INTEREST:** All Respondents to this RFP shall be advised that the successful 6/10 PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING **PRIME CONSULTANT and any SUB-CONSULTANT(S)** will be precluded from participating in the 6/10 NEPA CONTRACT concurrently solicited at this time.

#### **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

- **3-PAGE RIVIP BIDDER CERTIFICATION COVER FORM** must be completed and included as first entry in EACH Proposal submission. This is mandated by RIDOA and failure to include may result in disqualification.
- Required **FORMS (5)** as cited on must also be completed by the PRIME and submitted with each copy of LOI/TECH. **FOR W-9 ONLY, only one (1) unbound "ORIGINAL" COPY is required at time of submission.**
- **SUB-CONSULTANT Firms** need only submit the LOBBYING/ DEBARMENT AND DISCLOSURE Forms only.
- Proposal submission must be submitted not only in hard copy but also on CD ROM. Clearly labeled CD ROM should be included along with EACH proposal document package.
- All information should be bound in a **single volume**, include a **Table of Contents** and pages numbered in **consecutive order**.

#### **REGISTRATIONS:**

- In accordance with RI General Laws, no **FOREIGN CORPORATION**, (a corporation established other than in RI) has the right to transact business in RI until it has procured a **CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY** from the **OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE (401) 222-2357**.
- Also in accordance with RIGL, all persons practicing engineering in the State of Rhode Island must possess a **PROPER PE REGISTRATION** and **CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORIZATION FOR THE FIRM** and **FOR THE INDIVIDUALS** who would perform the work. Requirements and reference information are also outlined in RFP.

Per issuance by DOA of Addendum 7550287A1, the DUE DATE for this submission HAS BEEN EXTENDED to **MARCH 23, 2016 no later than 11:30 AM**; Submission package must be submitted to the **Division of Purchases** and should be clearly labeled as to **Bid # and Project Description (ORIG + 5)**

1. Q – Will the selected 6/10 NEPA and 6/10 PE Consultants be required to “work together” on the 6/10 Project?

2. Q – Is there currently any set project limits with regard to the location of the transit corridor?

***A – NOT AT THIS TIME. But the location of the corridor will have to focus on the Providence Metro area. The actual location sites will rely on the NEPA alternatives provided to determine any set limitations.***

3. Q- Did the Department ever consider any benefit to allowing the same Consultant to provide both NEPA and PE services under one contract?

***A- YES. RIDOT considered this option, however, RIDOT felt it was in the best interest for the Project that the Consultants for both Contracts remain separate with the Conflict of Interest provisions imposed.***
