**DESCRIPTION: R.I. Federal Aid Project Nos. STP-AWDA(029), 3RD-PRTY(235) and R.I. Contract No. 2015-CH-010 are for Downtown Sidewalks ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) Accessibility Improvements – Contract 3. The limits of the project are Dorrance Street from Fulton Street to Westminster Street, Exchange Street from Westminster Street to Fulton Street, Washington Street from Empire Street to Adrian Hall Way, Westminster Street from Dorrance Street to Exchange Street, and Weybosset Street from Dorrance Street to Westminster Street in the City of Providence, Providence County, Rhode Island. The project length is approximately 0.36 miles.**

**The work associated with the project includes, but is not limited to, removal of existing concrete and brick sidewalk and driveways; installation of new concrete and exposed aggregate sidewalk and driveways; installation of curb ramps and embedded detectable warning systems; removal and resetting of granite curb and installation of new granite curb; installation of thin lift fiber reinforced concrete overlay above underground basement vaults; micromilling of existing bituminous pavement and removal of existing brick pavers and placement of new hot mix asphalt; removal and resetting of cobblestone roadway and installation of new cobblestones to repair roadway; installation of new decorative bollards; removal and disposal of existing brick and cobblestone raised crosswalk and replacement with a bituminous raised crosswalk containing a decorative treatment; removal and resetting/relocating of parking meters and posts; removal and disposal of existing signs and installation of new signs; installation of pavement markings; removal and disposal of existing hydrants; installation of break-away hydrants; cleaning of existing catch basins; reconstruction of existing catch basins; removal and disposal of existing frames and grates and frames and covers and installation of new frames and grates and frames and covers; adjusting necessary utility castings; replacement of loop detectors; installation of decorative street lighting; implementing landscaping treatments to existing trees; removal and resetting of steel bike hitches; installation of new steel bike hitches; pre- and post-construction survey of existing structures and all other incidentals necessary to execute the work complete in place and accepted within the limits of this contract to the satisfaction of the Engineer.**

## QUEST LITE VERSION 4.4.8 (2.8.4)

### UPGRADE & FULL INSTALLATION

All bid offers prepared using the Department of Transportation's Quest Lite software must use the Quest Lite Version 040408 (2.8.4). If there is no Quest Lite installation, then the full installation must be completed. For earlier versions of Quest Lite, either the upgrade or full installation will be required to be completed. Both versions (upgrade and full installation) are provided on this project CD.

Before proceeding with any installations, note the following:

1. All users must register with the Department of Transportation in order to use Quest Lite. At the time of registration, users are provided with a set of unique company ID codes (Site Code, Bidder Code and company Short Name). Users **MUST RETAIN** these codes for future use.
2. Many users who currently have Quest Lite installed will only require the installation of the upgrade version. To determine if the upgrade installation is sufficient, the present version of the Quest Lite installation must be determined. This is accomplished in Quest Lite by clicking on Help/About. If the present version is 040407 (2.8.3) then the upgrade installation is sufficient **unless** an upgrade version has been previously used to upgrade version 2.8.2 to 2.8.3.
3. For earlier installations (versions below 2.8.3, and if an upgrade has been previously installed to upgrade to version 2.8.3), the full installation of Quest Lite is required. (Note: if the full installation is required, the upgrade installation **does not** need to be performed after the full installation is completed.)
4.
