

K-9 Screening/Evaluation Requirements

*The following points are guidelines for the screening and evaluation of potential new K9s for the Rhode Island State Police K9 Unit. The K9's to be selected are intended to be dual-purpose, Patrol / Narcotic detection K9's. Potential Vendor must complete the following chart and to provide the required requested documentation outlined below for **each individual K9 presented**:*

Outside environment: Agility structures such as tunnels? A-frames? Catwalks? Jumping obstacles?	
Is the K9 able to tolerate gunfire?	
Work Drive/Play Drive (tug or ball)	
Does the K9 demonstrate high drive with either food, play, or both?

Is Bite work balanced with prey and defense?

K9 Suitability and Testing


All portions of the testing process will be evaluated, reviewed and determined eligible at the discretion of the Rhode Island State Police Principle canine trainer. The Rhode Island State Police reserves the right to refrain from purchasing any K9 for any reason he/she feels the K9 would not be a reasonable candidate for the Rhode Island State Police K9 Unit. The Rhode Island State Police will be considering the following of each K9 presented:

Suitability:

- Provisional depending on the outcome of the interaction between the intended handler and the K9. This could be contingent of both the physical and mental attributes of both the K9 and the handler.
- Determined based on the requirement for the intended use of the K9.

Testing:

- The K9 must successfully complete the Basic K9 Patrol School. A medical and workability guarantee is required through the negotiated trial period.
- Rigorous test procedure administered by the RISPS K9 trainer to include but not limited to:



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- *Scent Work-Complex ground scent scenarios for tracking/evidence search scenarios.*
- *Balanced prey/defense aggression testing*
- *Agility: Walls, tunnels, catwalks, A-frames*

Vendor Requirements:

Since each K9 is a unique individual with varying attributes, the award(s) will be determined by the lowest responsible bidder and the Rhode Island State Police's evaluation of the individual K9s presented. The State reserves the right to award to one or multiple vendors. All vendors must agree to the following requirements:

1. *Must have all immunization and vaccination records on file for the K9(s) presented that meet the originating and Rhode Island states' laws.*
2. *Must have a reasonable trial period.*
3. *Must have a reasonable return policy allowing the K9 to be returned to the vendor where purchased for full refund within a trial period. (Vendors outside of the area will pay all expenses incurred to have the K9 returned if necessary.)*
4. *Must be able to demonstrate the K9's attributes upon viewing, if requested.*
5. *Vendor must provide a copy of their kennel license or similar applicable animal welfare license in the state in which they operate.*
6. *Must provide a reasonable warranty period on the K9 to be free of any genetic or medical condition(s) not resulting from training or work performed with the RISP K9 Unit.*
7. *Delivery:*
 - a. *In-State: Delivery via vehicle with adequate size, climate-controlled and secured space within the vehicle with provisions provided for the K9.*
 - b. *Out-Of-State: Delivery method and timing to be determined by mutual agreement. K9 must be enclosed with an appropriate size, secure crate or vehicle. Travel method must be climate-controlled with provisions and regular care provided for the K9.*
