PEDESTRIAN WAY**

**DESCRIPTION:** This item shall consist of providing an open pedestrian way across the Providence River Pedestrian Bridge by Completion Date No. 2 as set forth in Special Provisions Construction General Section 6 Paragraph H and special provision 108.1000. The pedestrian way shall be an eight (8) foot wide clear path across the bridge and extending between South Water Street and Eddy Street. Once opened on the designated date, the pedestrian way shall remain open for the duration of the contract except as allowed below.

**MATERIALS:** All materials shall conform to the applicable sections of the Rhode Island Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and supplemental specifications, and as specified elsewhere in the Contract Documents.

The pedestrian way shall be furnished with a suitable railing or fence to keep pedestrians away from the edge of the deck and falling into the river. The railing or fence shall meet all applicable AASHTO requirements for the proposed location on the bridge deck. The final bridge rail may be used for pedestrian way if it has been installed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

The Contractor shall submit his proposed method of providing the pedestrian way to the Engineer for review and approval as a shop drawing.

**CONSTRUCTION METHODS:** The methods of construction shall conform to the applicable sections of the Rhode Island Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and supplemental specifications, and as directed by the Engineer. The surface for the pedestrian way shall be the final surface of the bridge.

The pedestrian way shall only be suitable for pedestrians. Bicycles must be walked across the bridge. The pedestrian way shall extend beyond the bridge to South Water Street and Eddy Street along the proposed bituminous sidewalks shown on the plans.

The pedestrian way shall remain open at all times except that it may be closed on weekdays until 4 PM only to accommodate Contractor operations that will affect the safety of the pedestrians. The Contractor shall provide temporary lighting along the pedestrian way for nighttime use. The pedestrian way shall be kept free of obstacles, material stockpiles, equipment, dirt and debris. The entrance and exit shall be clearly marked.

**METHOD OF MEASUREMENT:** Item Code 937.9999 Pedestrian Way shall be measured for payment as a lump sum for all labor, materials and incidentals necessary to provide and maintain the pedestrian way, to keep it open at the requisite times, complete and accepted by the Engineer.

**BASIS OF PAYMENT:** Item Code 937.9999 Pedestrian Way, shall be paid for by the lump sum at the Contract Unit price listed in the proposal. This item shall be an only and acceptable price of \$50,000.00. The price shall include any and all temporary rails, fences, temporary lighting, maintenance, signs, and all other incidentals complete and accepted by the Engineer. No additional payment will be considered for delays or inefficiencies due to the presence of the pedestrian way.

The bituminous sidewalk beyond the bridge and the bridge deck will be paid for separately.
