NOTICE TO HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE CONTRACTORS

Sealed Proposals addressed to the State Purchasing Agent, Rhode Island Department of Administration, Division of Purchases, One Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island 02903, will be opened and read in public on July 20, 2016 at 1:00PM. All bidders MUST register online at www.purchasing.ri.gov. A Bidder Certification Cover Sheet MUST accompany each bid. Bid item description and quantities estimated for this project will also be available online. Should you need assistance in registering or downloading a bid, call (401) 222-3766. Failure to comply will result in mandatory disqualification per Item 4 of Section 12.102.12 of the Division of Purchases Procurement Regulations Adopted December 2010 and RI General Law 37-2-17 which references the RI Vendor Information Program (RIVIP).

DESCRIPTION: Rhode Island Contract No. 2016-CB-038, Funding No. REV-1950(001), County of Providence, City of Providence, Rhode Island: Improvements to Interstate Route 195, Contract 16. This Contract includes the construction of the Providence River Pedestrian Bridge, the East Side Boardwalk, East Side Riverwalls, modifications to existing cast-in-place retaining walls, and waterfront site improvements.

This contract includes extensive fabrication and construction of complex architectural elements.

The bridge construction includes: cast-in-place wingwalls, abutment stems and pier pedestals, and bridge decks; straight and curved steel plate girders and rolled sections; fabricated architectural steel bridge piers; timber framing; timber piles; micro piles; IPE timber decks; architectural rail systems; architectural WANA timber-steel framed fascia panels; architectural masonry; and extensive architectural lighting.

Site work includes riprap; precast concrete modular block riverwalls; grading; and embankment construction. Incidental construction includes site preparation; embankment construction; salt marsh planting; plantable soil and seed; maintenance and protection of traffic; dewatering; excavation; handling and disposal of contaminated soil; and all other incidentals, complete and accepted within the project.

The contract documents include digital models of the pedestrian bridge to be used by the Contractor for layout and to develop shop drawings. Experience with the use of digital models will be required.

The Contractor will be required, in accordance with the provisions of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Affirmative Action Certification for Contractors and Consultants, to meet the established Race-Conscious Goal, or Contract Goal, of not less than 4.00 percent of the contract bid price, to the Contractors, Subcontractors, and/or suppliers which qualify as Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's). Failure by the Contractor to demonstrate every good faith effort in fulfilling its DBE commitment during the construction period will result in the reduction in contract payments by the amount determined by multiplying the awarded contract value by the established DBE percentage, and subtracting the dollar value of the work actually performed by DBE contractors. This action will not preclude RIDOT from imposing sanctions or other remedies available as specified in paragraph (I)(C) of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Affirmative Action Certification for Contractors and Consultants.
