TITLE: Special Use Identification Tags (Temporary Plates) for Rhode Island licensed Dealerships.

Below is the only question received for this RFP. No further questions will be answered.

In Section 3, Page 5 of the solicitation the state requests: "Develop a system able to securely post transactions to a state-offered web-service for regulatory and law-enforcement purposes with low latency." Can the state provide any detail as to the specifics of the web service referenced in this requirement?

Answer:

Currently, the temporary plate data is stored on a private, (non-governmental) server. In order for law enforcement to obtain information on a temporary plate, they must access it through a vendor based database. The intent is to make this data available to law enforcement through the National Law Enforcement Telecommunication System (NLETS). Current regulations prohibit NLETS from connecting to private servers. There have been discussions as to how best to make this happen. The proposal would require the successful bidder to upload or transfer, in real time, this data to another server hosted by the DMV or other state agency, which would allow for an NLETS connection for access to the data.
