Request for Quote – Rigging Services

Blanket Request July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017

The William M. Davies, Jr. Career & Technical High School is seeking quotes for services for heavy rigging for machinery and equipment for Davies' machine technology and building construction programs. Charges are to be made on a time, equipment, and man-power basis. All equipment necessary to move the machinery and equipment is to be provided by the contractor, and is to be included within the quoted hourly rates. No other charges other than the hourly rates will be approved for payment. The equipment may involve a truck with hydraulic lift gate, standard rigging equipment, and special equipment necessary for a particular job.

Most of the rigging needs will occur in a compressed timeframe during the period of July and August, 2016, while the school is relocating its machine technology program to another area of the facility. The number of pieces of equipment that require rigging may range from 50-75 machines (table saws, routers, planers, lathes, grinders, milling machines, band saws, CNC vertical mills, CNC lathes, etc.). However, additional machinery rigging needs may occur during the course of the blanket period.

Time records must be maintained by each employee of the contractor every day. Failure to maintain time records will result in non-payment for those hours when invoices are subsequently presented for payment. Time is to be rounded to the nearest ¼ hour. Overtime is considered to be hours worked in excess of 8 hours during regular hours of operation. Regular hours are defined as anytime between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THIS BID

PURCHASE AGREEMENT BID

BIDDING (a) A single price shall be quoted for each item against which a proposal is submitted. This price will be the maximum in effect during the agreement period. Any price decline at the manufacturer's level shall be reflected in a reduction of the agreement price to the State. (b) Quantities, if any, are estimated only. The agreement shall cover the actual quantities ordering during the period. Deliveries will be billed at the single, firm, awarded unit price quoted regardless of the quantities ordered. (c) Bid price is net F.O.B. destination and shall include inside delivery at no extra cost. (d) Bids for single items and/or a small percentage of total items listed, may, at the State's sole option, be rejected as being non-responsive to the intent of this request. **ORDERING** (a) The User Agency(s) will submit individual orders for the various items and various quantities as may be required during the agreement period. (b) Exception - Regardless of any agreement resulting from this bid, the State reserves the right to solicit prices separately for any extra large requirements for delivery to specific destinations.
