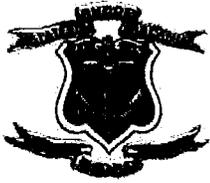

FUELS BULK STORAGE MAINTENANCE

1. The work area may be inspected by contacting CES Operations, at the Rhode Island Air National Guard, Quonset State Airport, North Kingstown, Rhode Island 02852-0794. The telephone number is 401-267-3226. The site will normally be available for inspection during normal duty hours, Tuesday to Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
2. Prospective bidders shall visit the site of the proposed work, (see attached list), and fully acquaint themselves with all conditions which can in any way effect the work or cost thereof.
3. All work will be accomplished during the normal duty hours from Tuesday to Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Holidays will not be included.
4. The work area shall be kept in a reasonably clean and orderly condition at all times. All debris will be removed at the end of each workday by the contractor.
5. Before proceeding with any work, the contractor shall notify CE Operations or his designated representative one week prior at 401 267-3226.
6. These plans and specifications contemplate the production of a top quality Maintenance Program. Any and all items necessary to obtain proper maintenance of equipment shall be included as part of the job whether or not specifically noted herein. All inspections will be IAW UFC 3-460-03F. Inspection item frequencies are attached.
7. Reasonable and proper safety precautions and practices shall be observed throughout the course of work.
8. All work will be performed under the direction of the Base Civil Engineer or his designated representative, and will be subject to his acceptance.
9. Contractor will provide supporting documentation of services and test results after each service or test is completed.
10. This contract will be for 3 consecutive years, maintenance and testing only.
11. Contractor shall quote amount on a per job basis for award of this contract.
