ADDENDUM DESCRIPTION: Amendments to "Section 6: Evaluation and Section" of the RFP Document

"Section 6: Evaluation and Section" (page 11) of the RFP document has been amended

FROM:

"Proposals will be reviewed by a Technical Review Committee comprised of staff from State agencies. To advance to the Demonstration/Interview stage, the Technical Proposal must receive a minimum of 50 (71.4%) out of a maximum of 70 technical points. To advance to the Cost Evaluation stage, the Technical Proposal including the Demonstration/Interview must receive a minimum of 58 (82.8%) out of a maximum of 70 technical points.

Any technical proposals scoring less than 58 points including the Demonstration/Interview will not have the cost component opened and evaluated and the proposal will be dropped from further consideration.

Proposals scoring 58 technical points or higher will be evaluated for cost and assigned up to a maximum of 30 points in the cost category, bringing the potential maximum score to 100 points.

The Office of Management and Budget reserves the exclusive right to select the individual(s) or firm (vendor) that it deems to be in its best interest to accomplish the project as specified herein; and conversely, reserves the right not to fund any proposal(s)."

TO:

“Proposals shall be reviewed by a Technical Review Committee comprised of staff from State agencies.

Technical Proposals must receive a minimum of 50 (71.4%) out of a maximum of 70 technical points to advance to the Demonstration/Interview stage. Technical Proposals scoring less than 50 points shall not advance to the Demonstration/Interview stage and not have the cost component opened the proposal shall be dropped from further consideration.

The Technical Proposal and Demonstration/Interview must receive a combined minimum score of 58 (82.8%) out of a maximum of 70 technical points to advance to the Cost Proposal evaluation stage.

Technical Proposals and Demonstrations/Interviews scoring a combined total of 58 technical points or higher shall be evaluated for cost and assigned up to a maximum of 30 points in the cost category, bringing the potential maximum score to 100 points.

The State reserves the right to select the individual(s) or firm (vendor) that it deems to be in the State’s best interest to accomplish the project as specified herein; and conversely, reserves the right to cancel the solicitation in its entirety.”
