SEALED PROPOSALS ADDRESSED TO THE STATE PURCHASING AGENT, 1 CAPITOL HILL, PROVIDENCE, R.I. 02908-5855 SHALL BE RECEIVED UNTIL May 22, 2006 at 1:40 P.M. At that time they will be opened and read in accordance with public bidding procedures.

BIDS SHALL BE SUBMITTED IN DUPLICATE ON THE FORMS PROVIDED WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. Plans and specifications for submitting bid proposals may be obtained from the State Building Commission, 2nd Floor, 1 Capitol Hill, Providence, R.I. Plans and Specifications may be examined at the Offices of the Department Mental Health, Retardation, & Hospitals, Division of Facilities & Maintenance, 19 Foster Road, Cranston, Rhode Island, every day except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. until the date of the bid opening.

A deposit of \$50.00 will be made for each set of Contract Documents. The deposit shall be refunded to all but the successful bidder, if the Plans and Specifications are returned in good condition within two weeks after the opening of the bid. No cash, personal or company checks shall be accepted. Deposits shall be certified check, bank check or money order. DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS MUST BE PICKED UP IN PERSON.

A certified check or BID BOND, payable to the State of Rhode Island in an amount equal to FIVE PERCENT (5%) of the proposal shall be submitted with the bid.

A PERFORMANCE and PAYMENT BOND equal to ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) of the Contract price, with a surety company registered and licensed in the State of Rhode Island, shall be required of the successful bidder.

This project is subject to Chapter 37-14.1 of Rhode Island General Laws et. seq., and regulations promulgated thereunder, which require that ten percent (10%) of the dollar value of work performed on the project be performed by minority business enterprises, and prevailing wage rates to be paid under the Contract for this project must be in accordance with those prevailing wages on file in the Rhode Island Department of Labor, Office of the Director.
