The Produce Safety Program was established through a cooperative agreement with FDA to implement the Produce Safety Rule (a component of the Food Safety Modernization Act) to reduce the risk of food-borne illness from produce. The Produce Safety Program is tasked with education, outreach, and enforcement of regulatory compliance for growers of covered produce within the State of Rhode Island. The Cooperative Agreement requires that states conduct a risk assessment of produce growers by identifying and mapping locations of key features at each produce farm (i.e. packing house, wellhead, livestock area). To complete this objective, the Produce Safety Program seeks to obtain four GPS Data Collector devices and four GIS Receivers (to be paired with the Data Collectors) for staff to utilize during education/outreach and regulatory compliance inspections.

The minimum requirements for GPS Data Collector and Receiver required by the Produce Safety Program within the Center for Food Protection are as follows:

Additional Considerations:

- The GPS Data Collector and the Receiver units must be from the same manufacturer to ensure seamless interoperability.
- The GPS Data Collector and Receiver units must be compatible with the Rhode Island local base station for corrections/processing (a Trimble Model 4700 reference station) which is located at the University of Rhode Island.
