The following questions were received from vendors regarding RFQ #7598764 ARMED SECURITY GUARD SERVICES AT 150 SOUTH MAIN STREET, PROVIDENCE, RI – AG

Vendor A

- 1. We note the requirements of a "fit for duty" physical exam in Armed Security Guard Scope of Work Section E.2 on page 2.
- What is the timing of the exam i.e. pre-employment versus annual?
- Please provide the criteria for satisfaction of the physical requirements:
 - o How were those determined?
 - o Was there any validation study done with respect to those standards?

Answer:

The selected vendor should provide personnel who are "fit for duty". While there are no specific measurement criteria set forth, it is expected that the selected vendor maintains minimum physical fitness standards for armed security personnel. Standards and evaluation for fitness will be left to the discretion of the vendor but should include: • appropriate height/weight proportions. • upper and lower body strength test. • the ability to sustain physical activity. • the ability to run at a reasonable rate for an intermediate distance without becoming fatigued. • a visual acuity test.

2. The armed security officer will be covering screenings at 150 South Main St. When an escort is needed by Security Officer to 180 South Main St. location, who will be responsible for covering the front desk and screenings area at 150 South Main St.?

Answer:

There is a receptionist at 150 South Main Street, who will address visitors and have them wait in the vestibule area until the security officer is back in the building. It should be noted that the 150 and 180 South Main Street buildings are adjacent to each other.

o escorting any visitors for 180 South Main Street to that building once they have been screened at 150 South Main St.?

Answer:

Visitors to 180 South Main Street, must first report to 150 South Main Street for screening and then be escorted to 180 South Main Street, which is adjacent to 150 South Main Street.
