RIDEM Proposal for Utilization of FY'18 Supplemental STAG Funding

1. Background

The Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM) conducts RCRA Compliance Evaluation Inspections (CEIs) at facilities that generate, store, transfer and treat hazardous waste as part of the Performing Partnership Agreement with the USEPA. A component of the inspection activity includes a process tour of the subject facility during which RIDEM staff walk through active production areas. Most companies utilize volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in industrial processes that generate emissions which may reach levels exceeding applicable OSHA standards and result in the unsafe exposures. During the inspections, RIDEM staff often encounter containers and tanks holding liquid wastes that are not properly labeled or identified by the company. Inspectors must use caution when approaching these units to assess potential instances of noncompliance without risking an unsafe exposure. The past practice has been to rely on the company's anticipated compliance with OSHA regulations and its personnel to ensure the inspection activity is conducted in a safe manner.

2. Project Scope

RIDEM will purchase and maintain a gas detection device for staff to use when inspecting facilities that are known to store, handle, process or distribute products containing VOCs.

RIDEM has reviewed various gas detection devices and determined that the MultiRAE Pro Gas Detector is the most cost-efficient device to fulfill this purpose. Please see the attached bid sheet dated October 2, 2018 for the unit's design and functional specifications. The cost of the unit will be Six Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars and Twenty-Nine Cents (\$6,234.29).

3. Findings

- >64% of the currently active Large Quantity Generators (LQGs) of hazardous waste utilize some form of VOC in their industrial process.
- 100% of the Treatment Storage and Disposal Facilities (TSDFs) receive and manage large volumes of VOCs.
- The most common violation observed by RIDEM inspectors is the failure to complete waste determinations.

4. Actions

RIDEM has decided to purchase a MultiRAE Detector to ensure that staff conducting RCRA inspections are not exposed to dangerous concentrations of chemical gases. The sensor would also be used to assist the inspectors when determining if the waste in a specific container or tank exhibits hazardous characteristics and requires a full hazardous waste determination. The purchase order for the MultiRAE will be submitted to management on or before November 15, 2018.

Also, the Department will take analytical samples of materials handled as non-hazardous to test compliance. This will either be done at a hazardous waste facility during compliance inspection or at another site managing non-hazardous wastes (such as facilities managing contaminated soils).

5. Takeaways

The inspectors use of a MultiRAE sensor will ensure that RIDEM staff are not exposed to unsafe concentrations of VOCs or enter areas that contain oxygen deprived atmospheres or gases at explosive levels. The sensor will also increase the efficiency of the identification of waste streams that require full analysis to determine its regulatory status.

Analytical sampling of "non-hazardous" waste will help ensure that waste characterizations are being properly done.
