QUESTION

There doesn't seem to be any Asset Management Software included in the bid. Would the utility like to see their system as a whole, including GIS Mapping?

ANSWER

We do not need the Asset Management software, we will be using our own VueWorks system to track work.

QUESTION

Would the utility like to have a webinar/demonstration of the Asset Management Software prior to the bid opening?

ANSWER

No, we will be using our own Asset Management system.

QUESTION

Is it the utility's intention to remove the portable reel from the inspection van for remote field inspections that are non-accessible from the van? If so, would you like a 3Kw portable generator included in the proposal?

ANSWER

Yes, we need the portable 3Kw generator

QUESTION

Camera shall have the ability to do laser measurement inside the pipe (measure cracks, bends, water level, pipe diameter ect...) Is it the Utility's intention to purchase a system that can measure the full profile of the pipe, or just a system that can measure cracks and deformities? If a full profile of the pipe is required, what size pipe diameters would the Utility need to profile?

ANSWER

Yes, we need to measure the full pipe profile. We need to measure pipe sizes ranging from 6" to 48" typically.

QUESTION

We recommend the addition of a Sonde for all CCTV cameras? Should this be included as part of the base quote for this bid or optional?

ANSWER

Yes, please include the Sonde for all CCTV cameras. Also include the topside locator wands.

QUESTION

Would the utility consider the Control Room walls and ceiling will be covered with a seamless Kemlite laminate instead of carpet?

ANSWER

Yes, we would accept seamless Kemlite laminate instead of carpet.

QUESTION:

Can the vendor submit more than one bid or model with their bid package?

ANSWER:

No, the vendor must pick the model that best meets the specifications (or exceeds). Only one bid per vendor will be accepted.

QUESTION

Would the utility rather have a 6.3Kw MEPS Inverter over the 3.0Kw Xantrax Inverter? MEPS Inverter offering more power output and will free up more space in the van, without the need for the additional batteries required with the Xantrax Inverter?

ANSWER

Yes, we would accept the 6.3 Kw MEPS Inverter over the 3.0 Kw Xantrax Inverter.

QUESTION

Where do you plan to store the following items in the bid or will you need additional storage cabinets, closets, ect for these items?

- Extension ladder (16' man hole type)
- Tool Package (Pick, shovel, sledge hammer, manhole hook)
- Tripod system for confined space entry
- Gas meter for confined space entry
- Hand hold extension lamp w/cable & 20' reel
- Confined space safety gear
- Manhole fence

ANSWER

Extension ladder – on roof rack on the truck. Tool package – on the truck. Tripod – on truck. Gas meter – on truck. Hand held extension lamp w/20' cable – on truck. Confined space gear – on truck. Manhole fence – on truck. Note, truck will also need to carry traffic cones.

QUESTION

Training for 24 employees. Is the utility looking for (1) Training Session for the entire group of employees? For Digital Side Scanning systems, 5 days of training is recommended. The bid specifications does not quantify how many days are required.

ANSWER

The bid should include all necessary training. We anticipate 6-10 people will be trained.

QUESTION

There is no mention of any opportunity to demonstrate the equipment on site. What is the protocol for being able to perform a live demo?

ANSWER

RIDOT will want a demonstration after the bid selection is completed.

QUESTION

Dodge does not list 87 MPH Max speed as an ordering option (77 MPH is the closest that is listed) (Power Train Section)

ANSWER

77 MPH is acceptable.

QUESTION

We do not see an ordering option to add a "Proportional Electronic Trailer Brake Controller". Would an aftermarket brake controller be sufficient? (Power Train Section)

ANSWER

An aftermarket brake controller is acceptable.

QUESTION

The wheels will be aluminum (The RV Ready Prep Package that is required makes this so with no other options) (Wheels and Tires Section)

ANSWER

Aluminum wheels are acceptable.

QUESTION

Dodge does not list the outside mirrors as "extendable" (Two options are a. Wide power/heated or b. short power/heated) (Safety Section)

ANSWER

Wide power/heated are acceptable.

QUESTION

We do not see an ordering option to add a factory back up alarm (Safety Section). Would an aftermarket back up alarm be sufficient?

ANSWER

An aftermarket backup alarm is acceptable.

QUESTION

Dodge does not specifically list where the cruise control will be, spec calls for it on steering wheel (Comfort and Convenience Section)

ANSWER

The cruise control shall be manufactures standard and factory installed.

QUESTION

Van comes standard with (1) 12V DC outlet, your bid specifications calls for Qty (2). There is an option to add one to the rear of the van, will this be sufficient? (Comfort & Convenience Section)

ANSWER

The second 12V DC outlet can be installed at a location in the operator's area.

QUESTION

What is the "Retained Accessory Power" listed on bid? (Comfort & Convenience Section)

ANSWER

The term "retained accessory power" means that the 12-volt circuits have power when the vehicle's ignition switch is in the off position.

QUESTION

The steering wheel is only listed as Telescoping, not tilting. (Comfort & Convenience Section)

ANSWER

This is acceptable.

QUESTION

Some of the Instrument measurements specified, we do not see listed as ordering options, will need to dig further into it to see if they are available. (Analog Instrumentation Section)

ANSWER

The instruments shall be the manufactures optional "gauge packet".

QUESTION

We do not see any kind of "Roof Racking" option available, possible aftermarket potential? (Exterior features)

ANSWER

An aftermarket Roof Rack is acceptable.

QUESTION

We do not see an option to add running boards to both the driver and passenger sides, possible aftermarket potential? (Exterior Features)

ANSWER

Aftermarket running boards are acceptable.

QUESTION

Page 7 of 19, One (1) RAX300 Automatic Cable Reel with 300M (1,000ft) cable. Should the cable be 300M long or 1000ft long?

ANSWER

Page 7 of 19 **CCTV PIPE INSPECTION CAMERA:**

Remove: "One (1) RAX300 Automatic Cable Reel with 300M (1,000ft) cable."

Replace: "One (1) RAX300 Automatic Cable Reel with 1,000 ft. cable."

QUESTION:

The delivery time in the specification is not long enough given the present conditions with the chassis manufacturers.

ANSWER:

Page 10 of 15 TRUCK DELIVERY SCHEDULE:

Remove: "Fabrication of the unit shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) days of the successful proposal."

Replace: "Fabrication of the unit shall be completed within two hundred and ten (210) days of the successful proposal."

QUESTION**Page 9 of 19 ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT:**

Is there a contact or vendor for the Motorola APX 1500 radio?

ANSWER:
