DESCRIPTION: Rhode Island Contract No. 2019-CH-026, Federal Aid Project No. STP-0114(026) and No. STPG-HSIP(068), for the Broad Street Regeneration project will consist of but is not limited to erosion control, sawcutting, excavation, micromilling, trimming and fine grading, gravel borrow subbase course, granite curbing, concrete sidewalk, new pavement, signing & striping, new closed drainage system, driveways, utility adjustments, new traffic signals, flagpersons, temporary construction signs, field office, mobilization, maintenance and protection of traffic, loam & seed, and other incidentals completed and accepted as necessary to complete the work of this contract as required by the Engineer.

Cities of Pawtucket and Central Falls, Town of Cumberland, County of Providence.

The Contractor will be required, in accordance with the provisions of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Affirmative Action Certification for Contractors and Consultants, to meet the established Race-Conscious Goal, or Contract Goal, of not less than 7.00 percent of the contract bid price, to the Contractors, Subcontractors, and/or suppliers which qualify as Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's). Failure by the Contractor to demonstrate every good faith effort in fulfilling its DBE commitment during the construction period will result in the reduction in contract payments by the amount determined by multiplying the awarded contract value by the established DBE percentage, and subtracting the dollar value of the work actually performed by DBE contractors. These parcels are affected by two-hundred twenty-four (224) temporary easements and are located along Broad Street at the intersections of Exchange Street and Goff Street in Pawtucket through the intersection of Mendon Road in Cumberland. The contract will not be awarded and notice to proceed issued until the Department has full legal access to areas needed for construction. Arrangements have been made to have all Right-of-Way (ROW) physically available on or before December 31, 2019.
