Buyer's introductory remarks:

This is a mandatory pre-bid conference. Only bids by those vendors on this sign in sheet will be evaluated.

Questions are being accepted on-line until 6/2 at 5pm. **(REVISED-SEE ABOVE)** Instructions how to submit questions is on page 1 of the bid.

This is a public works project and requires a CD be submitted with your bid. Instructions how to do that are included in the bid specifications. The State does not accept flash drives.

There are no allowances, alternates or unit prices. There are liquidated damages of 800 dollars per day.

Note the clauses that pertain to public works projects.

This is a prevailing wage job. There is a certification that needs to be signed and submitted with your bid.

Bid openings: As of right now the State is not allowing any vendors into the bid room. We are conducting bid openings using the ZOOM app. It is conducted just as if you were in the room. Vendor names and the bid price are read aloud. As this is a public copy bid the bids will be posted to the site almost immediately. People viewing the bid opening are asked to post their name and company name in the chat feature.

Instructions how to access the bid opening will be posted in an addendum.

Be advised that if you drop off your bid in person you must wear a mask and you will be asked a series of questions. Plan accordingly. The Division of Purchases does not accept late bids.
