Section 2.0: 24-Hour Emergency Response

Ability to Respond on a 24- Hour Basis


TMC maintains standard operating procedures (SOP) consisting of a 24 HR / 7 Day a week manned answering service, dedicated on call response teams, communications systems and a variety of equipment in a high state of readiness to respond to various types of incidents to include asbestos / air quality issues. TMC is a licensed State of Rhode Island Asbestos Contractor and has the required resources to include certified licensed asbestos supervisors and workers. (See Section 4.0)

TMC has a (2) full-time licensed RI Asbestos Supervisors residing in the State of Rhode Island and has the capability to respond on a 24-hour basis to initiate corrective action at the scene within one (1) hour. (See Response Map)

Normal Working Hours

TMC's normal working hours consist of straight time hours that begin at 7:00 AM and end at 3:30 PM. Day rates consist of a single 8-hour shift, Monday thru Friday.

1. LABOR RATES

STRAIGHT TIME

Full-time hourly employees receive straight time pay for the first 40 hours worked in a week.

OVERTIME

Full-time hourly employees receive overtime pay at the rate of 1-1/2 times the straight time rate for any hours worked over 40 in a regular workweek, for any hours worked on a Saturday, and for any hours worked on a holiday.

Full-time employees receive double-time pay at the rate of 2 times the straight time rate for any hours worked on a Sunday or a holiday.

WORKWEEK

The regular workweek is Sunday - Saturday
Normal business hours are 7:00am-3:30pm

PREVAILING WAGE

The Prevailing Wage rate multiplier of 138% will be applied to the straight time rate for any jobs that are covered under the Davis-Bacon Act. TMC Environmental agrees to comply with all State and Federal regulations regarding the application of Prevailing Wage rates in accordance with the general wage determinations issued under the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts.

Prevailing Wage will apply only to those hours that an employee is working on site.

Prevailing Wage will not apply to any hours spent traveling to and from a job site. Those hours will be billed as straight time hours at standard rates.

2. BILLABLE HOURS

Labor hours for personnel will be billed for time actually spent at the job site under the authority of a State On Scene Coordinator (SOSC) or designee and time actually spent traveling to and from the work site in excess of normal commuting distances for the area, which is a 25-mile radius from Providence.

A minimum charge of four (4) hours will apply to all personnel.

Straight time rates will apply to the first 8 hours worked in a day, Monday through Friday.

Overtime rates will apply to any hours worked over 8, Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday.

Double-time rates will apply to any hours worked on a Sunday and holidays.

Fractional parts of an hour will be billed on a prorated basis to the nearest quarter hour.

3. EQUIPMENT RATES

Where hourly, daily, and weekly rates are provided, the rates that result in the lowest aggregate amount shall apply.

The standby rate will apply when called for by the SOSC but not used, and during any periods where the equipment is being cleaned or decontaminated.

4. SUBCONTRACTORS & MATERIALS

Items that are not specifically defined in the bid to include markups or material handling charges, all subcontracts, non-MPA services, equipment and supplies will be subject to negotiation and approval of the SOSC, and no subcontract placed under this contract shall provide for payment on a cost plus percentage of cost basis.

5. ANALYTICAL

If deemed necessary, any laboratory analysis that may be required will be completed through RI Analytical or at a lab of the State's choice.

6. DISPOSAL

The Massachusetts Transporter Fee will be charged on all waste disposed of in the State of Massachusetts. This is a variable fee currently \$0.2640 cents per gallon and \$0.0264 cents per pound as manifested.

All disposal pricing is given with respect to a 55-gallon drum
All other drum sizes are as follows:

85-gallon drums will be charged at 145% of the 55-gallon drum rate
30-gallon drums will be charged at 75% of the 55-gallon drum rate
15-gallon drums will be charged at 60% of the 55-gallon drum rate
5-gallon drums will be priced on a case-by-case basis

Unless otherwise listed, bulk pricing will be determined on a TBN basis.

Disposal pricing does not include state hazardous waste taxes or regulatory fees that may apply.

7. STORAGE CHARGES

Any drums or waste taken into TMC custody will be stored at the licensed disposal facility to await final disposition. Standard transportation charges will apply and there will be no entry or storage fees.

8. INVOICING

Invoicing will be completed within sixty (60) calendar days from the completion of services or monthly, in the case of ongoing jobs. Invoices will be generated from daily worksheets, bills of lading, and manifests.

Terms are Net 15 days from the receipt of the invoice.

9. ENERGY & SECURITY RECOVERY FEE

The State of Rhode Island will not be subject to any Security, Insurance, Energy or Recovery Fee.

10. PRICE INCREASES

With respect to Section 2.2 of the Bidder Certification Cover Form, TMC agrees to hold pricing firm for the initial contract period of two (2) years. Sixty (60) days prior to each subsequent option year and any contract extension thereafter, TMC will calculate a price adjustment using the unadjusted Consumer Price Index (CPI) as published by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, <http://www.bls.gov/cpi/home.htm> and the national price of diesel fuel.

11. RESPONDER IMMUNITY

It is assumed that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the RFP documents, it is understood and agreed by the parties that Contractor will at all times under this Agreement retain any exemption or limitation from liability (“Responder Immunity”) pursuant to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended (FWPCA) 33 U.S.C.A. § 1251 et seq., the Oil Pollution Act of 1990, as amended (OPA-90) 33 U.S.C.A. § 2701 et seq., G.L.R.I. § 46-12.3-8., and any other applicable Federal, state or local law, regulation or ordinance which provides such responder immunity.

12. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

It is implied that through the issuance of a Master Purchase Agreement, the State of Rhode Island concurs with all pricing, terms, and conditions contained in this RFP package.
